17 Days

DAY 1: 3rd MARCH 2026
WINDHOEK

You will be met at the airport in Windhoek by your guide and we will head straight to River Crossing to recover from your flight. Sunset from the deck offers a great welcome to Namibia.

OVERNIGHT: River Crossing

EXCLUDED: Flight to Namibia, Visa if required

DAY 2, 3 & 4: 4TH, 5TH & 6TH MARCH 2026
ETOSHA – SOUTH

Today we head north to Etosha National Park, unique in Africa and known for its salt pan that is so large it can be seen from space. The next three nights are spent inside the park's southern camp overlooking a floodlit waterhole. This has to be the most famous of all waterholes and many guests choose to not do a game drive but to just sit and watch the game come to them. Each full day in the park includes a morning and afternoon game drive with your guide.

OVERNIGHT: Okaukuejo Camp

MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

INCLUDED: Etosha NP Cons Fee



DAY 5: 7th MARCH 2026
ETOSHA - CENTRAL

As we explore the park, enjoying an extended game drive we make our way to Halali Camp, central to the Eastern part of the park. A visit to the waterhole in the evening is a must as this camp is best known for its high numbers of Black Rhino that visit the camp's floodlit waterhole at night to drink.

MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner
INCLUDED: Etosha NP Cons Fee

DAY 6: 8th MARCH 2026
ETOSHA - EAST

In the morning we continue to explore the park. Enjoying an extended game drive we make our way to Namutoni Camp in the very eastern section of the park. Once again, the camp has a waterhole well visited by elephants.

We enjoy a full day exploring the Eastern part of the park.

OVERNIGHT: Namutoni Camp Etosha
MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner
INCLUDED: Etosha NP Cons Fee

DAY 7: 9th MARCH 2026
KAISOSI RIVER CAMP

We leave Etosha today after breakfast and a short morning game drive, making our way towards the Caprivi Strip which is a small thin stretch of land locked between Angola and Botswana. Tonight we will rest on the banks of the Kavango River which flows from here into Botswana where it becomes known as the Okavango. Just on the other side of the river from Kaisosi River Camp is Angola.

OVERNIGHT: Kaisosi River Camp
MEALS: Breakfast.
OPTIONAL: River sunset cruise.



DAY 8 & 9: 10TH & 11TH MARCH 2026
CAPRIVI

Travelling through the Caprivi the change in landscape is extremely obvious and different in comparison to dry Etosha. The fertile and wet Caprivi is bordered by the Okavango Delta on one end and the junction of the Chobe and Zambezi rivers at the other end.

We spend two days in the Caprivi at Namushasha River Camp discovering some of Caprivi's hidden gems. Game drives and boat cruises are used to explore this area.

- OVERNIGHT:** Namushasha River Camp
MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner
INCLUDED: One game drive and one boat cruise, park fees.

DAY 10, 11 & 12 : 12th, 13th & 14th March 2026
VICTORIA FALLS

Today we briefly cross into Botswana, and then into Zimbabwe. We spend the next three nights in Victoria Falls.

Day 11 is spent in Zimbabwe exploring Victoria Falls. After breakfast we will walk the Zimbabwe side of the falls (about 2,1 km but fairly flat and at this time of year very wet). In the afternoon you can choose to either explore the town of Victoria Falls on your own, OR book an optional 15 minute helicopter flight known as *The Flight of Angels*, OR visit the local craft markets. In the late afternoon we will enjoy a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River.

On Day 12 we head back into Botswana to spend the day in Chobe National Park, home to Africa's biggest Elephant population. Enjoy a game drive in the park and a boat cruise on the Chobe River, before returning to our lodgings at Victoria Falls.

- OVERNIGHT:** Rainbow Hotel Victoria Falls
MEALS: Breakfast.(Lunch in Chobe)
INCLUDED: Boat cruise on the Zambezi and the Chobe River. Walking tour of the falls and park fees.
EXCLUDED: Visa for Botswana and Zimbabwe if required
OPTIONAL: Flight of Angels Helicopter flight.



DAY 13: 15th MARCH 2026
JOHANNESBURG

Today is a travel day. After breakfast we make our way to the airport to fly to Johannesburg.

- OVERNIGHT:** Africa Sky Guest House
MEALS: Breakfast
INCLUDED: Airport transfers. Flight to Johannesburg.

DAY 14: 16th MARCH 2026
MANYELETI

An early morning departure as we head for the Manyeleti Private Reserve, comprising privately managed land adjoining the Kruger National Park. The Manyeleti uses open safari vehicles and allows you to go off-road to game view - ensuring the best possible opportunities for sightings of the Big Five.

OVERNIGHT: Khoka Moya
MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner
INCLUDED: Flight to Manyeleti, park fees, scheduled game activities



DAY 15 : 17TH MARCH 2026
MANYELETI

A full day exploring the area of the Manyeleti. Morning and sunset game drives each lasting between 3 to 4 hours.

OVERNIGHT: Khoka Moya
MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
INCLUDED: Park fees, scheduled game activities

DAY 16 : 18TH MARCH 2026
MANYELETI

Spend time game viewing; sightings are close, as 4x4 game viewers go off-road. A highlight is Manyeleti sunset drive where you'll get the opportunity to spot Manyeleti's many nocturnal animals.

OVERNIGHT: Khoka Moya
HMEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
INCLUDED: Park fees, scheduled game activities



DAY 17: 19th MARCH 2026
END

Today we head to the airport and fly back to Johannesburg. Unfortunately it's time to say goodbye as the tour comes to an end. We expect to be back in Johannesburg by 14:00 and request that you book an evening flight out of Johannesburg (any flight that departs after 17:00 would be suitable).

MEALS: Breakfast
INCLUDED: Airport transfers. Flight to Johannesburg.
EXCLUDED: All other flights

Single Supplement fee is USD 2275
