1st to 15th March 2027

Day 1, 1st March – Delhi
Upon your arrival in Delhi, India, we will meet and greet at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Dinner will depend on your flight and what time you arrive in Delhi.

Overnight at : Hotel Regent Grand

Day 2 , 2nd March – Bandhavgarh
Today, after our breakfast, we head for the airport to fly to Jabalpur, and then drive to Badhavgarh. So today is pretty much a travel day.

Overnight at : Tigergarth Resort

Day 3 – 5 , 3rd 4th & 5th March – Bandhavgarh National Park

Each day we will enjoy a morning and afternoon game drive, looking for the parks specials and so much more. The National Park is most famous for its great sightings of Tiger, Gaur (Indian Bison) and Sloth bears, but has so much more to offer. Overnight at : Tigergarth Resort



Day 5, 5th March – Kanha National Park

After a morning game drive in Bandhavgarh, we drive to Kanha National Park.

Overnight at : Infinity Resort Kanha

Day 6 & 7, 6th and 7th March – Kanha NP

For the next two days we will have morning and afternoon game drives in Kanha National Park. This park is most famous for saving the Barasingha (swamp deer), which is endemic to the park but offers many more highlights like Tigers, leopards, and Dhole (Indian Wild Dogs)

Overnight at : Infinity Resort Kanha

Day 8, 8th March Pench National Park

After morning game drive we drive to Pench National Park. Lunch on route.

Overnight at : The Sole Tree





Day 9 & 10, 9 & 10 March - Pench NP
Morning & Afternoon game drives in the Pench National park. This is the park that inspired Rudyard's Kipling book "The Jungle Book" so all the main characters are found in this park.

Overnight at : The Sole Tree

Day 11, 11th March – Satpura National Park
After breakfast, we drive to Satpura National Park, with Lunch along the way. If time permits, we can enjoy a night drive in the buffer of the National Park, This is the only area where we are allowed to do night drives offering a totally different safari experience.

Overnight at : Leher Sa Resort

Day 12 & 13, 12 & 13 March – Satpura NP
This park has many of the main target species but is also home to a few special ones like the Giant Indian Squirrel. The park also allows us to explore it in different ways like a boat safari or night drives.

Overnight at : Leher Sa Resort

Day 14, 14th March - Delhi

After a morning boat safari and lunch in the park, we drive to Bhopal to catch our flight back to Delhi

Overnight at : Hotel Regent Grand

Day 15, 24th Jan – End of tour or Day 1 for SNOW LEOPARDS

We hope you will join on a snow leopard trip into the Himalayas to find the rarest of the big cats, and so much more.

WHAT TO PACK

Comfortable neutral clothing, avoiding white and bright colours. Expect hot days and cooler mornings/evenings. A mixture of summer and winter clothing is ideal, and a warm hat, jacket and gloves will keep you warm on night game drives when the wind chill factor in a moving open vehicle can make life a little chilly!

Other essentials include comfortable, durable walking shoes, hat and sunscreen, camera and binoculars, toiletries, insect repellent, hand sanitizer, etc.
