TANZANIA GREAT MIGRATION 13 DAYS

DAY 1: 12th February 2027
ARUMERU (ARUSHA)

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport and transfer to Arusha Town (1 hour). Depending on what time your flight lands you may have time to enjoy the gardens and an opportunity to photograph three types of monkeys including the rare Black and white Colobus monkey (only found here).

OVERNIGHT: Rivertrees

MEALS: None

INCLUDED: Transfers from Kilimanjaro Airport to lodge

EXCLUDED: Flight to Kilimanjaro, Visa if required



DAY 2: 13th FEBRUARY 2027
TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After a leisurely breakfast we depart to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire has the greatest concentration of wildlife in Tanzania and in dry season the Tarangire River is a magnet for thirsty wildlife. Large herds of elephants and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland gather. Not surprisingly, the predators follow. This is also the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as oryx and gerenuk are regularly spotted. Tarangire is also known for its spectacular baobab trees and its breath-taking views of the Masai Steppe and the mountains to the south.

OVERNIGHT: Tarangire Safari Lodge

MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

INCLUDED: NP fees and Afternoon game drive

DAY 3: 14th FEBRUARY 2027
KARATU

After breakfast we spend the morning doing a game drive in the park. Then we head out and make our way to the town of Karatu where we will spend the next two nights at Farmhouse Valley. This lodge is perfectly situated to access the Ngorongoro Crater and by spending two nights there it means we can explore the crater for a full day.

On route to Farmhouse and as we climb up towards the rim of the Rift Valley, we will experience some great views of Lake Manyara.

OVERNIGHT: Farmhouse/Farmhouse Valley

MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

INCLUDED: NP fees.



DAY 4: 15th FEBRUARY 2027
NGORONGORO CRATER

After breakfast depart with picnic lunch to Ngorongoro Crater for a full day's game drive. Descend into the crater to view game on the vast grasslands of the crater floor. Spectacular animal life can be found throughout the year due to the permanent availability of grass and water. This is one of the world's most iconic wildlife experiences.

OVERNIGHT: Farmhouse /Farmhouse Valley

MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

INCLUDED: Full day game drive in Ngorongoro Crater and NP fees

DAY 5, 6 & 7 : 16, 17 & 18 FEBRUARY 2027
NGORONGORO CONSERVANCY

Our lodge for the next three nights is my favourite lodge in Northern Tanzania, Masek Tented Camp. Its location overlooking Lake Masek is fantastic. At this time of year we expect the migration to be somewhere between central and Southern Serengeti. When they reach the south the migration slows to an almost stop to give birth. However, the migration can never really stop due to the sheer numbers of animals and the amount of food they consume daily.

Since this is not part of the National Park (Serengeti) but actually part of the conservancy it means that in the right conditions we can venture off road and get close to all the major sightings. The reason I have chosen three nights here, is because I expect to find the migration here and this tour has been designed with the hope that we will catch the migration giving birth. It can obviously never be guaranteed but it is very special this time of year.

OVERNIGHT: Masek Tented Camp

MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

INCLUDED: Morning and Afternoon game drives in Ngorongoro, Park fees



DAY 8 & 9: 19 & 20 FEBRUARY 2027
CENTRAL SERENGETI

After breakfast we enter and make our way to the Central Serengeti, home to the predators. Expect to see big numbers of Lion, Leopard and Cheetah along with so much more wildlife. While the bulk of the migration is further south (where we have just visited), there is still lots of wildlife in this very special place.

Based at Kati Kati Tented Camp, each day will offer morning and afternoon game drives. Should we wish to range further on one of the days, we can take a picnic lunch and enjoy a full-day drive.

OVERNIGHT: Kati Kati Tented Camp

MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

INCLUDED: Morning and Afternoon game drives in the Serengeti, NP fees

DAY 10: 21 FEBRUARY 2027
ZANZIBAR

After breakfast we make our way to the airport in Central Serengeti. This is where we will say goodbye to our team of drivers and guides, but it is not the end of our trip yet. Today we fly to an island off the coast of mainland Tanzania... Full of mystery and charm, just the name conjures up images of tropical beaches and spices. We head to Zanzibar for three nights.

In the price below is shows the 10 days safari and Zanzibar Separate. Should you choose not to go to Zanzibar, then today will be the end of your safari and your flight will take you back to Arusha.

If you choose Zanzibar your in for a treat. Cocooned among 32 hectares of tropical gardens, fringed by a pristine mile-long beach, The Residence Zanzibar immerses you in the splendour of a secluded hideaway. Teeming with natural beauty, explore the treasures of the wild, retreat to a world of divine relaxation, bespoke hospitality and enchanting elegance inspired by the island's African, Omani and European heritage.

DAY 11: 22 FEBRUARY 2027
ZANZIBAR - BEACH

A full day at leisure to enjoy the beach and everything the hotel has to offer. The Residence offers a range of complimentary non-motorised activities, or you can sign up for a number of tours. We recommend a day at the beach and a visit to the Spa for a little pampering, or, for the curious, a walk to find the endemic Red Colobus Monkeys that like to play in the gardens.

Optional full day snorkelling trip with a lunch on a sand bar, is a great way to spend the day.

OVERNIGHT: The Residence Zanzibar

MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

INCLUDED: Non-motorised activities offered by the accommodation

OPTIONAL: Full day snorkelling trip with lunch on sand bar USD 250pp Minimum 4



DAY 12 : 23 FEBRUARY 2027
STONE TOWN

After breakfast we head to visit the main centre of the island. In the afternoon enjoy an optional walking tour of the centre to learn the fascinating history of the island and city, or spend it at leisure. The Freddy Mercury Museum is also a popular attraction to visit (yes, Freddy Mercury was born in Stone Town).

OVERNIGHT: Zanzibar Serena Stone Town

MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

EXCLUDED: Optional walking tour of Stone Town USD50pp

DAY 13: 24 FEBRUARY 2027
END

Morning at leisure. We have included a harbour or an airport transfer in the afternoon as most flights depart later in the day. This is where I say goodbye to you.

Note:

- Most flights depart later in the day. Zanzibar is an international airport with many destinations. Your tour does NOT include return flights as there are so many destination options (we suggest that when booking your international flights you list the departure point as Zanzibar).
- For those wishing to explore further, ferries are available to Dar es Salaam (Tanzania mainland) and some of the surrounding islands.

MEALS: Breakfast

INCLUDED: Airport or harbour transfer

EXCLUDED: Any transport or visa required from Zanzibar
